If you think you stopped the military recruiter from getting your contact information by signing an Opt Out form, think again?

## STUDENT PRIVACY

Did you know...

- The Pentagon is collecting an illegal data base of 30 million 16-25 year olds that includes over 700 pieces of information including your contact information, ethnicity, email address, family information, school information, your grades, activities, work and college information and much more. - If you take the ASVAB (Armed Services Vocational Aptitude Battery) as 2/3 of all U.S. high schools, you will be asked to sign a privacy waiver granting the military recruiters your contact information, social security number, gender, and race or ethnicity. **EVEN IF YOU SIGNED AN OPT OUT FORM, your contact information will be available to military recruiters.**

**If the school (not individual) selects an Option 8, the military gives the test without using it for recruiting purposes.**

- Also beware - military recruiters can without your knowledge obtain your privacy information from many sources including: my space websites, teen magazines, class ring companies, from classmates, any raffles you sign, etc. etc. **PARENTS AND STUDENTS REMEMBER...**  
**You don't have to talk to military recruiters ever!**
