## Opt Out Campaign: Setting Up a Leafleting Action

Anyone can pass out the Opt Out forms to students in front of the high schools in Los Angeles. Consider organizing one with an organization, group, or with some friends. Here's how...

1. First, find out the following from the high school:
  - What time the bell rings before or after school (whenever you're planning the action)
  - If anything unusual is happening at your school the day you pick for your action (shortened day)  
You can look online for a calendar or call the school attendance office.
  - Where the students enter/exit in the morning or afternoon.
  - Where you want leafleters to meet. The main entrance is usually the best.
  - The number of students so you'll know how many flyers to bring.
2. Prepare flyers and signs. A sample Opt Out poster will be available on the web site. Bring enough Spanish flyers, especially for the parents who bring their children to school.
3. Leafleting Day
  - Arrive about an hour before the bell rings. You can reach the students and parents who come early.
  - Gather at the main entrance, pass out materials and break into groups to cover each entrance/exit.
  - Always stay on the public sidewalk; it's your first amendment right. Be careful not to go on school property or block entrances or exits.
  - Go up to the parents in their cars as they stop to drop off their children.

\*It's best not to inform the administration prior to your action.
