AN-TAG-O-NISM: fighting that leads to opposition and active resistance

HU-MIL-I-A-TION: being mean and cruel to someone to make them feel small and worthless

PEACE DIV-ID-END: money that could have been spent on social needs after the Cold War ended

ARMS RACE: when one nation starts to build weapons and in turn forces another nation to match them gun for gun, bomb for bomb

STRA-TE-GIC: an intelligent, well-thought out way of doing things

IN-FRA-STRUCT-URE: the roads, buildings, and services that make a society work

ASS-ASS-I-NA-TION: murder of an important person in a planned attack
